This is with reference to above mentioned subject regarding extension of provisional approval of affiliation **Indian Institute of Legal Studies, Darjeeling, West Bengal** which has already applied for extension of approval of affiliation for the academic year 2018-19 and inspection of the Bar Council of India is pending.

The matter relating to colleges similarly placed were considered by the Bar Council of India at its meeting held on 25th & 26th May 2018. The resolution passed was as follows:

“RESOLVED that colleges whose inspection fee has been deposited, application for extension of approval of affiliation is pending, no inspection could be done or the inspection has been done, but inspection report could not be placed before the Legal Education Committee or the Standing Committee for its consideration, then such colleges may continue to admit students only for the academic year 2018-2019. This will apply only in case where affiliation has been granted by the University which of course shall be subject to the inspection to be made by the Bar Council of India subsequently.”

Since your university has given affiliation for the year 2018-2019, you are requested to allow **Indian Institute of Legal Studies, Darjeeling, West Bengal** to admit students in **three year LL.B as well as five year BA LL.B, five year BBA LL.B and five year B.Com LL.B law courses** with existing sections for the academic year 2018-2019.


