2. Discuss the concept and theories of Liability. Explain the applicability of doctrine of *mens rea* with its exceptions in India by the help of decided case laws.
3. Write a comprehensive note on Legal Personality and Corporate Personality. Summarise the Theories of Corporate Personality.
4. "Ownership is *de-jure* recognition of a claim to certain property and Possession is the prima facie evidence of Ownership." Describe the relationship between Ownership and Possession in the purview of the above stated contradiction.
5. Elaborately explain the contribution of John Rawls in Distributive Justice. Write a comprehensive note on Criminal Justice System in India.
6. "A liberty is that which I may do innocently: a power is that which I can do effectively; a right in the narrow sense is that which other persons ought to do on my behalf."
